New Features and Enhancements 2022.1

Altair Inspire Render 2022.1 includes the following enhancements and resolved issues:

- Moved the Material Library to the browser panel.
- Moved the Environment Library to the browser panel.
- Moved the Models Library to the browser panel.
- Added a search/filter bar for models, materials, and environments in the browser panel.
- Added support for "Spring" simulation data.
- Fixed an issue where saving a current model with a format other than .iStudio would overwrite the file as .iStudio.
- Fixed an issue causing Copy and Paste not to work.
- Fixed a crash when deleting objects.
- Fixed issues with the materials list when dragging objects from one group to another.
- Fixed a crash when rendering an animation.
- Updated SpaceMouse support.
- Added support for particle geometry.
- Fixed an issue where choosing "Save Selected as Model" would save the entire scene.
- Fixed an issue preventing the camera zoom from working when using Shift+Ctrl+RMB to drag.
- Fixed an issue on Mac with mouse controls using the Command key instead of Control key.
- Invisible objects in the Material List are now shown in grey text.



Workflow help appears when you select a tool that opens a guide bar or microdialog. The text prompts you what to do next.


